

MARS AND MERCURY - EUROPE STANDING ORDERS

Day-to-day management of the Commission

The day-to-day management of the Commission is carried out by the general Secretary under the responsibility of the Board.

Membership fee

Each active member is required to pay an annual fee determined by the Board and approved by the General Assembly.

This fee, based on the number of members of the various national Circles, is calculated, for the year n, on the basis of the number of members of these Circles on the 31st December of the year n-1.

The membership fee must be paid no later than the 30th June of the current year.

Membership fee effective 1st January, 2017, amounts :

- a basic membership fee for each national Circle : 150 euros
- a membership fee per registered member as of the 31st December of the previous year : 0,75 euros.

Presidency rotation order

The Presidency rotation order is determined as follows :

- 1) Circle Poland (renonciation)
- 2) Circle Grand-Duchy of Luxembourg
- 3) Circle Belgium
- 4) Circle Denmark
- 5) Circle Spain
- 6) Circle Germany
- 7) Circle France
- 8) Circle Switzerland
- 9) Circle The Netherlands

Any Circle becoming a new member of Mars and Mercury Europe will be added to the bottom of the list for the Presidency's tour de role.

Presidency

- The general President animates the Commission by organizing at least annually an international meeting in addition to the General Assembly in a country of his choice. This event can be organized in conjunction with a national Circle event.
- The general Vice-President and future general President will present the program for his mandate of the next three years to the General Assembly. This program is not subject to a decision of the General Assembly.
